Surfing with dogs has become more popular, especially in California where they have the sunny weather and the waves. Most surfers claim that their dogs loved water and it was natural to put them on a surfboard. Having a dog that loves water and is an excellent swimmer is most important, then safety. All dogs who surf have to have excellent obedience. They must listen and perform the commands. They also have to wear a doggy PFD-personal floatation device, and some wear dog wet suits. Companies like SurfDog, give lessons. There are many Southern California competitions, usually starting in April through September. The biggest competitions are Unleashed, sponsored by SurfDog and PetCO and Purina Pro Plans Incredible Dog Surf Dog Challenge, which is by invitation only! 
