

Two books you might have missed: Dog Man, An Uncommon Life on a Faraway Mountain by Martha Sherill and Animals Make Us


Human by Temple Grandin. Dog Man is a true account of Morie Sawataishi who, during WWII, discovered that Akitas were being slaughtered for pelts. It became his mission to change his life and save the breed. Temple Grandin's book is the culmination of over 30 years of scientific research working with all kinds of animals and learning how to read animals cues and fulfill their needs. A must read for anyone with animals in their life.

The Glass-Handel project seeks to make opera and classical music more accessible. Anthony Roth Costanzo is bringing music, dance, visual art, and theater together for a new take on the music of George Frideric Handel and Philip Glass.
